Connection to programme competences or aims

Defining of competence.

Learning outcomes for the session

At the end of this session trainers will be able to:

- Describe at least three perspectives on the use of Social Entrepreneurship in achieving a goal in a particular context
- Identify the main elements of the competence of Social Entrepreneurship.
- Define the competence of "Social Entrepreneurship"

Experience of working with students in non-formal contexts.
