Activity: Think Big: Revitalize your Community

Addresses: Social Entrepreneurship

Aims/Intended Learning Outcomes: Promote entrepreneurship and put your community on the map. Host a forum that creates and initiates discussion about public policy, entrepreneurship, and specific ideas to benefit your community.

Time required: minimum 1 hour

Group size: 8-10 minimum

Context/setting: In the classroom - On the campus - In the Halls of

Residence - Outdoors

Description:

Brainstorm possible entrepreneurial and business ventures.

Put the students in group and tell them to think in real social needs in their community, context, town...

Then, each group has to choose one of those needs and create a project to satisfy those needs.

At the end each group shares their project with the big group.

Materials needed: paper and pens-markers- A handout of how to make a project.
