What's next?

Provisional activities for Padova summer school (it is better not to do the same activities in local implementation):

- ice breaking activities, i.e. cue ordered by date of birth, blind person in the group
 - Masterchef
 - Talent show
 - Preparing and conducting debates
 - Cultural and intercultural presentation
 - Leadership through ages and places (including three leadership metaphors)
 - Reflective activities/debriefing

It is important to agree on:

- 1. Number of hours for March-June local activities, timetable
- 2. General framework of local activities, competence dimensions and learning outcomes expected before Padova summer school (each partner can implement different activities according to the context, both students-led and trainers-led activities)
- 3. Virtual space for sharing local activities (inspiring each other)
- 4. Mapping students' previous ideas on the 3 competences
- 5. Collecting evidences and reflection from local activities to set up a portfolio to be used as well in Padova
- 6. Ways and times of putting students in contact among different institutions

Some provisional proposals:

- 1. Up to 20 hours in total; selection of 6-9 dimensions (mid March)
- 2. All partners may address all three competences, including common background literature to students
- 3. Each partner sends to Dorothy/shares the selected competences dimensions and a description of the activities to be implemented in 2015 (mid March)
- 4. Introductory activity with students: mapping their ideas/definitions of the three competences (see UNIPD slides)
- 5. Revision of student portfolio template by mid March
- 6. Facebook/twitter, platform/blog

Padova's example for portfolio

- Personal data
- My educational path (formal), summery of thesis, left or interrupted studies, formative path (informal, nonformal, e.g. courses at work, voyages, lectures...)
- My professional path (professional experience)
- My extra-professional path (sport, hobbies, charity work...)
- My DARE+ experience: learning event, learning outcome(s), link to prior experience, impact on personal and professional context
- Summary of knowledge, skills and competences acquired by professional and extraprofessional experiences
- Scheme of self-evaluation template
- Europass CV and European Languages Portfolio
- Peer assessment
- Records of documents (highlights)

What are your ideas for local activities?

- Mapping students' previous ideas on the three competences and sharing common literature reference
 - Introduction of portfolio to participating students
- Who are we? Shared life exercise: what is your shared life in your residence? + Introduction to own City/university (including at least a shared text outcome)
- Common blog/facebook group for intercultural interaction
 - What else? Each partner designs its own activities
