Activity: Lipdub

Addresses: Teamwork; Leadership; Communication

Aims/Intended Learning Outcomes: Students develop their creativity, their ability to communicate through different ways of expression. They have to express themselves by means of an audiovisual language and show their life in the city.

**Time required:** As long as needed for recording their part of Lipdub. It requires extra time for planning, rehearsal, recording and editing.

**Group size:** Students work in groups of 3 to 4 people and the chosen song is divided in so many parts as groups are.

Context/setting: Outdoors

**Description:** A lipdub is a type of video that combines lip synching and audio dubbing to make a music video. It is made by filming individuals or a group of people lip synching while listening to a song or any recorded audio then dubbing over it in post editing with the original audio of the song. We can suggest some interesting topics and the students will have to develop a lipdub about this issue in groups. It implies designing, rehearsal, recording and editing, several tasks where they will work in teams assuming different roles.
