

Activity: Junior enterprise

Addresses: Teamwork; Leadership; Communication; Conflict Resolution; Intercultural Competence; Project Development & Management; Social Entrepreneurship

Aims/Intended Learning Outcomes: The main objective is to design a project of junior enterprise having in mind all the activities and workshop carried out. This future company will be based on a social entrepreneurship that responds to social needs around them.

Time required: A face to face session of one hour to explain the activity; the time of autonomous work that student need to develop the activity and a final session of one hour to explain the projects.

Group size: Small groups of at least three people

Context/setting: In the classroom - Outdoors

Description:

1. Firstly in the first session students are divided in groups of at least three people and are explained the task to do. Working in groups they will have to design a company that responds to social needs around them. It's important that they try to take advantage of their own potentialities and the features of the society that they know.
2. They work outside the class to prepare the project.
3. In the final session each team explain their project to the others. This session can be recorded
