

Activity: Videopresentations

Addresses: Communication; Intercultural Competence; Teamwork.

Aims/Intended Learning Outcomes: Communicating spontaneously, creating an atmosphere of equality and collaboration. Students develop their creativity and their competences of communication in front of a video camera using not only oral communication but nonverbal expression as well.

Time required: The students will have a short time for preparing this presentation and after that, recording will be made. Total time: around 30-45 minutes.

Group size: There is no minimum or maximum size for this activity.

Context/setting: In the classroom - On the campus - Outdoors

Description: Students will work in the creation of individual videopresentations of themselves. These will be short presentations, no more than 2 minutes long, where students will talk about their careers and about their expectations regarding this project. The final results could be posted in the blog of the project so that they can start to know each other.

Grouping: Students could work in small groups in order to support each other in this task.

Variations: Students, in groups of 3 or 4, could talk about the main reasons for coming to the city and studying at their University.

Materials needed: Video camera or any device that could record video presentations (smartphone, tablet, etc.).
